Determining Reading Fluency - Achieve the Core Aligned ...

In order for students to

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be able to self-assess their fluency using this rubric, they need to “hear” themselves as readers. Rather than asking students to read-aloud, listen to themselves, and then self-assess, I think it’s much more effective to teach students to record their thinking, play it back, and then self-assess.

Fluency pyramids. Fluency pyramids are similar to fluency phrases and can be done as a warm-up in guided reading. Take a short sentence with high-frequency words and write one word of

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the sentence on the first line. Then two words on the second line, etc. Finally, students will read the pyramid.
